

The Majority Decides! Get Out of Gaza, Start to Talk



On May 2nd, in a closed party referendum, around 60,000 hard-line Likud members defeated Prime Minister Sharon's proposal to evacuate settlers from all of Gaza and four West Bank settlements.

On May 15th, more than 150,000 Israelis rallied in Rabin Square in Tel Aviv to give their reply. In the clearest possible terms, they said that a majority of Israelis supports evacuating Gaza and returning to peace negotiations—that a tiny minority of settlers and right-wing fanatics should not be allowed to determine the destiny of the Jewish State.

The Israeli Peace Now movement is proud to have helped organize this massive demonstration in support of settler evacuation and a return to peace talks, along with the Labor Party, the Meretz-Yahad Party, the One Nation Party, the kibbutz movements, the Geneva initiative organizers, youth groups, and the Forum of Bereaved Parents.

Poll after poll shows that a solid majority of Israelis—including most Likud voters—wants out of the settlements.

Peace Now and Americans for Peace Now are working hard to give voice to this majority.
