It is a grave threat to Israel's security

The settlers are not giving up. Neither are the American Jews who help to bankroll them.

Although Israel's Cabinet has approved Sharon's proposed withdrawal from the Gaza Strip and four West Bank settlements, hard-line settlers are determined to stop it. Some call for civil disobedience. Others are organizing a massive, grassroots political and media campaign against evacuating any settlements.

Some of the settlers' funding comes from right wing American Jews who have financed Israeli extremism for years. There is a dangerous partnership, one that ignores the reality that Israel cannot be secure until the occupation ends.

Americans for Peace Now and Israel's Peace Now movement have a different kind of partnership. We are working to give voice to the majority of Israelis who, polls show, want to get out of the settlements and start negotiating for a two-state solution.

It pains us to confront Jews who love Israel as much as we do. But we cannot give the enemies of compromise a black check in the months and years ahead. If they fail to stop the Gaza plan, they will certainly redouble efforts to retain and expand West Bank settlements. They will keep trying to hijack Israel's future.
